Intermediate Spanish is a one-semester, three-credit course that covers the following topics:

Lesson 10

Vocabulary: health expressions, emotions, leisure activities

Grammar: reflexive verbs, 'faltar' and 'quedar', review of past descriptive (imperfect) for habitual events

Lesson 11

Vocabulary: leisure activities and places

Grammar: review of preterite, use of preterite vs. imperfect

Lesson 12

Vocabulary: consequences of activities

Grammar: 'ver' in the imperfect, affirmative and negative 'tú' commands

Lesson 13

Vocabulary: describing personalities Grammar: present perfect, reflexives

Lesson 14

Vocabulary: where you live

Grammar: conditional mood, review of direct and indirect object pronouns

Lesson 15

Vocabulary: location, directions

Grammar: review of reciprocal reflexives

Lesson 16

Vocabulary: clothing, travel Grammar: conditional mood

Lesson 17

Vocabulary: professions, traits

Grammar: subjunctive mood after indefinite antecedents and expression of future intent

Grammar: simple future, subjunctive mood with expressions of uncertainty
